

HTML Tag Hangman

Play a group game of hangman on a whiteboard, using HTML tags as the words. Include punctuation but leave the letters as blank spaces. Participants should take turns guessing a letter.

Some examples:

<i>Tag</i>	<i>Write as:</i>
<code><!DOCTYPE></code>	<code><!_ _ _ _ _></code>
<code></code>	<code><_ _ _ _ _></code>
<code><p></code>	<code><_></code>
<code><bold></code> <i>(use with an advanced group, and be sure to note that this is not best practice anymore – they should use instead)</i>	<code><_ _ _ _></code>

Use any tags you like, and after each round, get the group to define the tag to check their learning. Ask questions like:

- What does this tag do?
- Does it need a closing tag?
- How would you use this?
- Should you use this? (if you choose outdated tags like `<bold>`)
- What tag should you use instead?
