It is the responsibility of the requesting party to ensure that files provided for printing are legally obtained, either as open-source files or as a purchased licensing agreement. Furthermore, if any breach of copyright does occur, the requesting party will be responsible for any fines and penalties incurred.

The manager of the MakerSpace reserves the right to refuse to print any model for any reason. All print jobs will go through an approval process prior to printing.

Olds College will not use any material for printing that is not owned by Olds College itself. This is to protect the integrity of our machines and to reduce our liability in the case of model malfunction.

If modification of the file is necessary, there will be an additional charge. If a file is deemed too badly damaged for printing, the requester will be informed and the model will not be processed.
